CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend section 3982 of the revised statutes, relating to guardians and wards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3982, R. S. 1878.

Guardians may
settle claims
for ward.

SECTION 1. Section 3982 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "Such guardian may also, with the approval of the county judge, adjust, compromise and discharge any and all claims for damages which his ward may have, and any compromise and discharge of such claims heretofore made by any such guardian, in good faith, with the approval of the county judge, is hereby legalized and declared valid."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to amend chapter 23, of the private and local laws of Wisconsin for the year 1867, entitled "An act to incorporate the Wisconsin yearly meeting of Freewill Baptists."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
