CHAPTER 465.

AN ACT to amend chapter 358, of the laws of 1887, relating to a clerk in the office of the state superintendent.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 1 and 2, of chapter 358, of the laws of 1887, are hereby amended so as to read as follows: Section 1. The state superintendent is hereby authorized to appoint one clerk, in addition to the chief clerk now provided for that office, who shall, under the direction of the state superintendent, aid in promoting the establishment, maintenance and control of libraries as provided by law.

Amends chapter 358, laws of 1887.

Appointment of clerk; his duties.

SECTION 2. The salary of the additional clerk authorized by this act shall not exceed twelve hundred dollars per annum, and shall be paid in the same manner as the salaries of all other clerks in departments, and the expenses of such additional clerk, actually incurred in the performance of duty herein specified, not exceeding in any one year the sum of two hundred and twenty-five dollars, shall be certified monthly by the state superintendent, and the salary shall be paid and expenses reimbursed from the state treasury, and there is hereby annually appropriated from the general funds in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient sum to carry into effect the provisions of this act.

Salary.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
