terms of court for the Sixteenth judicial circuit shall be held as follows: For the county of Marathon, the first Monday in May, the second Monday in September and the second Monday in November; but no jury shall be summoned for the September term. For the county of Lincoln, the second Monday in January and the second Monday in July. For the county of Oneida, the first Monday in March and the first Monday in Special terms, October. Every general term in each of said counties shall be a special term for all the other counties in said circuit.

Section 2. So much of chapter 41, of the laws of 1891, as is in conflict with this act, is hereby pealed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect from and

after May 1, 1893.

## CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT to cede to the United States jurisdiction over the Sturgeon Bay and Lake Michigan ship canal.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Consent given SECTION 1. The consent of the states of the purchase by Consin is hereby given to the purchase, by the United States, of the Sturgeon Bay and Lake Michigan ship canal, connecting the water of Green Bay with Lake Michigan, in said state, and all the lands pertaining thereto; and the state hereby cedes to the United States exclusive jurisdiction over said canal and lands during the time the United States shall be or remain the owner thereof, for all purposes except the administration of the criminal laws of said state, and the

Jurisdiction.

service of civil process thereon. Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
