who are properly entitled to such aid, and in the distribution of such grain and potatoes.

Governor may employ assistants.

SECTION 3. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered to employ such aid and assistance as in his judgment may be necessary to determine the amount and kind of seed to be purchased under the provisions of this act, and for the proper distribution thereof.

SECTION 4. Such portion (if any) of the sum revert to state, appropriated by this act as shall not have been expended as herein provided, on or before the first day of July, 1895, shall be covered into the general fund, and the duties of the governor under this act shall cease.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT to amend section 2479, of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes, relating to mileage of jurors in county courts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Mileage of jurors, how computed.

SECTION 1. Section 2479, of Sanborn and Berryman's annotated statutes of the state of Wisconsin, is hereby amended by striking out the words "but no mileage" where they occur in the third line of said section, and inserting in place thereof, the words "and six cents per mile for each mile actually traveled in going and returning by the most usual route, but shall be paid for no day when court is not in session unless specially ordered by the presiding judge," so that said section when so

amended shall read as follows: Section 2479. All jurors summoned and attending such county courts shall receive two dollars per day, and one dollar for each half day's attendance; and six cents per mile for each mile actually traveled in going and returning by the most usual route, but shall be paid for no day when court is not in session, unless specially ordered by the presiding judge to be paid out of the county treasury upon like certificates as jurors in circuit courts are paid.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and pub-

lication.

CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to the Wisconsin State Horticultural Society.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated SL500 approthe sum of fifteen hundred dollars out of the briated annugeneral fund annually to the Wisconsin State Horticultural society, and five hundred dollars to establish an additional experiment station.

SECTION 2. Chapter 117, of the laws of 1893,

is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
