CHAPTER 373.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of committees of county boards within the state, and amendatory of section 668, of the revised statutes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 668, of the revised statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Amending sec. 668, R. S.—Appointment of committees.
 Section 668. Any county board may, by resolution designating the purposes and prescribing the duties thereof and manner of reporting, authorize their chairman to appoint before the first day of November in any year a committee or committees from the members of the county board elect; and the committees so appointed shall perform the duties and report as prescribed in such resolution. The members of such committee shall receive such compensation Compensation. for their services as the county board shall allow, not exceeding the per diem and mileage allowed to members of the county board, but no supervisor shall be allowed pay as a member of any such committee for more than twenty days in any one year, nor for mileage except in connection with such services performed within the time herein limited. Provided, this shall not apply to committees appointed to have charge of the erection of court houses, jails or other county buildings. Provided, further, that no member shall draw for committee work done while county board is in session.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
