

chase, lease or condemnation; and in case said Bertrand G. Chandos and George E. Hoskinson, their heirs, associates and assigns, are unable to agree with the owners of such lands so necessary for said purposes, for purchase, lease or use thereof, and the right of flowage thereof, or as to compensation to be made for taking or flooding any such lands, then they, the said Bertrand G. Chandos and George E. Hoskinson, their associates, heirs and assigns, may acquire the same by proceedings of condemnation, in the manner provided and set forth in section 1777, of the revised statutes of this state, as amended by chapter 318, of the laws of 1882, the provisions of which said section and chapter are hereby made applicable for the purpose of acquiring any such lands, for the purpose aforesaid, under this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 83.

AN ACT to amend chapter 2, of the general laws of the state of Wisconsin for 1893, and to fix the time, for holding the term of court for the several counties in the ninth judicial circuit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Terms of court
in the ninth
judicial circuit.

SECTION 1. Section 3, of said chapter 2, of the laws of 1893, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The terms of the circuit court for the several counties of the ninth judicial circuit shall be as follows: For the county of

Adams, the first Tuesday in June and the third Tuesday in December. For the county of Columbia, the second Tuesday in May and the first Tuesday in December. For the county of Dane, the second Monday in January, the Monday after the first Tuesday in April, the fourth Monday in June, and the third Monday in September; but no jury shall be summoned for the term in June. For the county of Marquette, the second Tuesday in June, and the Tuesday after the third Monday in November. For the county of Sauk, the second Tuesday in March, and the third Tuesday in October. Every general term in the counties of Columbia, Dane, Marquette and Sauk shall be a special term for the whole judicial circuit.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to authorize the construction and operation of telegraph and telephone lines within the limits of public highways.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person or persons may, with the written consent of the supervisors of the town, construct and operate a line of telegraph or telephone along and within the limits of any highway, subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in section 2, of this act.
