## CHAPTER 53.

AN ACT to provide for an increase of income of normal schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. ## CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT authorizing corporations, organized under chapter 91, of the revised statutes of Wisconsin for the year 1878, to change their names.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Corporations authorized to change their names. Section 1. Any corporation heretofore or hereafter organized under chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes of Wisconsin for the year 1878, may change its corporate name and adopt any other. Such change may be made at either a regular annual meeting of such corporation or at a special meeting called for that purpose, by resolution adopted by a majority of the members thereof and spread upon the records of such
