

son, as aforesaid, may enter upon any unimproved lands adjoining to or near the highway in his district and gather or dig any stones, gravel, or sand, clay or loam, and cut any wood or trees, and take away the same, for the purpose of making or improving such highway; but such overseer or other person shall carefully avoid doing any unnecessary injury upon the same; and in case there shall be within the limits of the highway in any road district any stone, gravel or sand suitable for the improvement of any highway, the same may be taken to improve any highway in any adjoining road district, but the consent in writing of the supervisors of the town in which the said road districts are located shall be first obtained therefor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT to change the boundary lines of the towns of Buena Vista, Ithaca and Orion, in the county of Richland, in the state of Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The following described territory within the present boundaries of the town of Ithaca, in the county of Richland, is hereby detached from said town of Ithaca and attached

to and made a part of the town of Buena Vista, in said county, to-wit: Sections number one, two, three, four, five, six and the north half of sections number seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve, township number nine north, of range number two, east.

SECTION 2. The following described territory within the boundaries of Ithaca and Buena Vista, in the county of Richland, is hereby detached from said towns of Ithaca and Buena Vista and attached to and made a part of the town of Orion, in said county, to-wit: Section one and the north half of section twelve, of town number nine (Ithaca) north, of range number one, east, and the south half of section number twelve and sections number thirteen, twenty-four, twenty-five and thirty-six of town number nine (Buena Vista) north, of range number one, east.

SECTION 3. This act shall in no wise invalidate or affect the collection of taxes, or the return of lands for the non-payment of taxes, heretofore assessed upon the land embraced in the territory described in sections one and two of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
