CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money to Otto Neitge and Julius Neitge.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The state treasurer of Wisconsin is hereby authorized and directed to refund to Otto Neitge and Julius Neitge, as sole surviving heirs of George Otto Neitge, deceased, the sum of four hundred eight and two-hundredths dollars, same being that certain sum of money deposited by said George Otto Neitge with the state treasurer in 1874 to secure certain St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad lands and since that date carried on the treasurer's books to the credit of the said St. Croix and Lake Superior railroad deposit fund.

Moneys deposited with treasurer in 1874 appropriated to heirs of depositor.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
