CHAPTER 264.

AN ACT to authorize W. H. Dick, his associates and assigns, to maintain dams and make improvements on Embarrass river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:

Location of dam. SECTION 1. W. H. Dick, his associates and assigns, are hereby authorized to maintain dams across the Embarrass river on northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, section thirty-six town twenty-seven range twelve east, also on northwest quarter of the southeast quarter section seven town twenty-six range fourteen east, and to make improvements on the river between the dams hereby authorized in blasting rocks, straightening and clearing the channel of obstructions to log driving.

Log slides and fishways. SECTION 2. There shall be maintained suitable slides and gates in the said dams for running logs and timber over the same. The control of the said dams, slides and gates shall belong to W. H. Dick his associates and assigns. There shall be maintained suitable fishways in said dams.

Rates chargeable for passage of logs. SECTION 3. As compensation for the use of the dams and improvements while driving logs and timber over the same, W. H. Dick his associates and assigns, are authorized to charge and collect from the owner of logs and timber who use the said dams and improvements, the sum of five cents per thousand feet, board measure, for passing over each dam and five cents per thousand feet for passing over and through the improvements in the channel hereby authorized and the same shall be a lien on the logs and timber and may be collected in the same manner as claims for labor are collected.

Right to amend or repeal reserved. SECTION 4. The right to alter, amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
