**CHAPTER 417.**

AN ACT to re-enact section 1211 of the statutes of 1898 and to repeal section 2 of chapter 308 of the laws of 1899.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin represented in senate and assembly do enact as follows:*

**Statement of gross earnings, etc., to state treasurer.** SECTION 1. Section 1211 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1211. Every steam or electric railroad company and every person operating a railroad in this state, except railroads operated by horsepower or city street railroads wholly within such city shall on or before the tenth day of February in each year, make and return to the state treasurer in such form and upon such blank as shall be furnished by him, a true statement of the gross earnings of their respective roads for the preceding calendar year, of the number of miles of road operated by each such company or person and the gross earnings per mile per annum during such year; which statement shall be verified by the oath of the secretary and treasurer of such companies or of the person so operating such railroad.

**Repealed law.** SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 308 of the laws of 1899 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
