granted to corporations by sections 1777a, 1777b, 1777c and 1777d of the revised statutes of Wisconsin, and such amendments thereto as may have been or may be made.

Intent of act. Section 5. No corporate powers are granted by this act, and it shall not be construed or deemed to grant such powers.

Legislative rights reserved. Section 6. The power to alter, amend or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

Section 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 365.

AN ACT, authorizing H. M. Seaver, her heirs, associates or assigns, to rebuild and maintain a dam on Little Wolf river.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Location of dam; flood gates and slides. Section 1. For the purpose of improving navigation and developing hydraulic power, H. M. Seaver, her heirs, associates or assigns, are hereby authorized to rebuild and maintain the dam now erected on the northeast quarter of section 34, town 24, range 13 east, across the Little Wolf river. Suitable flood gates and slides to permit of the free and casy passage of logs over and through the said dam shall be built and maintained in said dam.

Fishway. Section 2. There shall be built and maintained in the dam hereby authorized such fishways as may be required by the commissioner of fisheries.

Legislative rights reserved. Section 3. The right to amend, alter or repeal this act is hereby reserved.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 366.

AN ACT, to amend section 1 of chapter 355 of the laws of 1897, relating to the number and salaries of the assistants of the superintendent of public property.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Additional assistants authorized. Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 355 of the laws of 1897 is hereby amended by striking out in said section under the subdivision "superintendent of public property" the words "two firemen" and insert in lieu thereof the words "three firemen," and also by adding at the end of said subdivision the words, "one man, at a salary of seventy-five dollars per month, who shall attend to the electrical work, and such other work as the superintendent of public property shall direct."

Section 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
