CHAPTER 154.

AN ACT to amend section 6 of chapter 67 of the laws of 1903, fixing a penalty relating to unclean and unsanitary milk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Penalty. Section 1. Section 6 of chapter 67 of the laws of 1903 is hereby amended by striking out the words "and, in default of payment thereof," where said words occur in said section 6, and inserting in place thereof the word "or," so that said section when so amended shall read as follows: Section 6. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each and every offense, * * or shall be imprisoned in the county jail not less than thirty days nor more than sixty days.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 155.

AN ACT to amend section 3733 of the statutes of 1898 relating to replevin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Affidavit may be amended. Section 1. Section 3733 of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended by adding to the same the following clause: "Such affidavit may be amended to the same effect as is provided in section 3702."
