## CHAPTER 356.

AN ACT to amend section 1941—40, of the statutes of 1898, relating to reports of retail lumber dealer's insurance associations.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**Report of lumber dealer's insurance associations.** SECTION 1. Section 1941—40, of the statutes of 1898 is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 1941—40.\* *The president or the vice-president and the secretary shall annually on or before the 31st day of January prepare and file in the office of the commissioner of insurance a detailed statement, verified by their oaths, of the business of the corporation during the year and its condition on the 31st day of December next preceding, such statement to show the number of policies issued, and the amounts insured thereby, the number of assessments and the amounts paid upon each, the losses sustained, and whether the same have been paid or adjusted, or remain unpaid or unadjusted, or are resisted, the amount of assessments unpaid, the number of new policies issued, and an itemized statement of the expenses, the amount and condition of its funds and any other information called for by the commissioner. A copy of such statement shall be submitted to the members of the association at the annual meeting.*

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
