CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT to authorize the county of Dunn to construct and maintain a free wagon bridge over and across the Chippewa river in Dunn county at a point designated by the county board of said county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Construction of bridge authorized. SECTION 1. The county of Dunn and its successors and assigns are hereby authorized to build, construct and maintain a free wagon bridge over and across the Chippewa river, at a point within said county of Dunn designated by the county board of said county. And for such purposes may erect piers and build embankments and approaches in said Chippewa river and on the banks thereof, necessary for the proper and convenient construction and maintenance of said bridge; provided that the location and construction of such bridge shall be approved by the war department of the United States.

Law repealed. SECTION 2. Chapter 322 of the laws of 1887 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
