CHAPTER 62.

AN ACT to authorize Kimberly and Clark Company, its successors and assigns, to construct and maintain a foot-bridge across the Fox river, in Outagamie county, Wisconsin, from the town of Buchanan, on the south side, to the town of Kaukauna, on the north side.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Foot-bridge across Fox river authorized. SECTION 1. Kimberly and Clark Company, a Wisconsin corporation, with home office at Neenah, Winnebago county, Wisconsin, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized to construct and maintain, for the use of itself, its successors and assigns, and the public a free foot-bridge across the Fox river on any land they own or have a right of use, for such purpose, in Outagamie county, Wisconsin, from a point on the south side of said Fox river, in the town of Buchanan, at or near the village of Kimberly, to a point on the north side of said Fox river, in the town of Kaukauna. Provided, that a suitable draw be built and maintained and operated in said bridge for the passage of boats; and that said bridge be so constructed as not necessarily to interfere with navigation; and that same be constructed according to plans approved by the chief of engineers and by the secretary of war of United States.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
