CHAPTER 7.

AN ACT relating to the terms of court in the fifth judicial circuit, and amendatory of chapter 13, of the laws of 1901.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Fifth circuit. SECTION 1. Chapter 13 of the general laws of Wisconsin for the year 1901 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: The subdivision of section 2424, Wisconsin statutes 1898, on page 1748 of said statutes, which fixes the times for the holding of terms of court in the fifth judicial circuit is hereby amended so that * * * subdivision when amended shall read as follows: Fifth Circuit: In the county of Grant on the third Monday in February and the second Monday in October; in the county of Iowa on the *fourth* Monday in March and the fourth Monday in September; in the county of Lafayette on the first Monday in June and the first Monday in December; in the county of Richland on the second Tuesday in April and the second Tuesday in September; in the county of Crawford on the second Tuesday before the first Monday in June and the second Tuesday in November.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication.
