SECTION 3. There is added to chapter 338, laws of 1903, amending chapter 373, laws of 1901, a new section to be known as section 6, which reads: (Sec. 411—6a.)

Section 4. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 602.

AN ACT to provide for the expenditure of any surplus moneys remaining from the appropriation for the monument for exgovernor Nelson Dewey.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Expenses of dedication ceremonies. Section 1. The commission created by chapter 93, laws of 1899 and chapter 390 [370], laws of 1905, to supervise the expenditure of the money appropriated for the erection of a suitable monument for exgovernor Nelson Dewey, is authorized and empowered to pay, out of any unexpended balance remaining in the appropriation for the erection of such monument, the expenses of the governor and ex-governors of the state of Wisconsin incurred in attending the dedication ceremonies of said monument.
