The sheriff of Outagamie county, \* \* \* his deputies, or any constable of the county \* \* \* may serve and execute the civil and criminal process of said court, provided however, that the city marshall, his deputy, and the police officers of the cities of Appleton and Kaukauna, shall \* \* \* be required to serve and execute all process issued out of said court wherein such city is a party plaintiff.
