## CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT appropriating to the county of Grant in Wisconsin the amount of overpayment on account of fines collected within the county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the county of Grant in Wisconsin the sum of fifty-nine dollars fifty-three cents, the said sum being that in the possession of the state treasurer arising from overpayment made by said treasurer to the state treasurer during the years 1904, 1905 and 1906 on account of fines collected within the county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT to repay to Portage county a five per cent overpayment of inheritance tax paid by said county to the state treasurer and to make an appropriation therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of seventy-nine dollars and forty-two cents, being five per cent of the amount of the inheritance tax paid by Portage county to the state treasurer from July first, 1904, to July tenth, 1906, and which should have been retained by the treasurer of said county, shall be repaid without interest to the treasurer of said county.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of any money of the general fund not otherwise appropriated a sum of seventy-nine dollars and forty-two cents to repay the sum so received by the state.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
