

building belonging to such district, is shut out from all public highways by being surrounded on all sides by real estate belonging to persons other than such district, the said supervisors shall immediately proceed to lay out a public highway to such schoolhouse site. The giving of notices, the order of laying out such highway, the award of damages, and the assessment of benefits and the payments thereof and the filing of the same, the appeal from such order or award, the opening of such highway, and the duties of the supervisors of a town relative to the laying out and opening of highways, as provided by law, shall be followed and applicable to the laying out of a highway to a schoolhouse site, except section 1283 of the statutes shall not be applicable to the laying out of such highway. A highway laid out in pursuance of this section shall be under the authority of the supervisors of the town in which such highway is situated, and no such highway shall be discontinued so long as a school is maintained on the site to which such highway is laid.

CHAPTER 319.

AN ACT to amend section 406a of the statutes, relating to the annual appropriation for normal schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 406a of the statutes is amended to read: Section 406a. For the purpose of conducting and maintaining the normal schools, there shall be levied and collected annually, a state tax of * * * *three* hundred and * * * *forty* thousand * * * dollars, which amount is * * * annually appropriated to the normal school fund income.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
