CHAPTER 349.

AN ACT to create section 1836m of the statutes, relating to the abandonment by railway companies of culverts and passes beneath tracks.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 1836m. It shall be unlawful for any railroad to so fill in, close up, or fence in any water-way, culvert, or underneath cattle pass of a size sufficient to permit the passage of cattle or other stock which shall have been maintained, allowed or permitted to be in and used as a passage way for cattle or other stock through or across the right-of-way for a period of five years as to prevent its use as a passage way for cattle or other stock without having first secured the consent in writing of the abutting land owners.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 350.

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money for the continuance of the Wisconsin Workshop for the blind.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of sixteen thousand dollars, including the unexpended balance in the state treasury appropriated by chapter 506, laws of 1907. [sections 572a, 572b, 572c and 572d.] to be expended by the state board of control in executing the requirements of said chapter from December, 1908, to June 30, 1911.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
