CHAPTER 408.

AN ACT to amend subsection 22 of section 170 of the statutes, relating to salaries of employes in the office of the state board of control and to allow the state board of control to employ one additional clerk.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 22 of section 170 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 170.) 22.

- a. The members of the state board of control of Wisconsin reformatory, charitable and penal institutions, each two thousand dollars. Each member of said board shall also be reimbursed all the actual and necessary disbursements paid out in the discharge of his duties.
- b. The secretary of the state board of control twenty-five hundred dollars, and he shall also be reimbursed all actual and necessary disbursements paid out in the discharge of his duties.
- c. The other persons employed in the office of the board of control the following sums: A chief clerk fifteen hundred dollars, a first assistant chief clerk eleven hundred dollars, a second assistant chief clerk nine hundred dollars, * * * two additional clerks eight hundred dollars each and a stenographer eight hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
