CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to amend section 1561 of the statutes, relating to penalty for drunkenness.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1561 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 1561. Any person found in any public place in such a state of intoxication as to disturb others or unable, by reason of his condition, to care for his own safety or the safety of others. shall, upon conviction thereof, he punished by a fine not exceeding *** *** *twenty-five* dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than *** *** *ten* days, or by both such fine and imprisonment; but this section shall not abridge the powers of cities and villages to provide a different mode of punishment for such offenses nor he applicable to any city or village which has, pursuant to its charter, enacted an ordinance for the punishment of such offense.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT to amend section 1976 and to repeal section 1955x--1 of the statutes, relating to the license of agents of insurance companies.
