CHAPTER 171.

AN ACT to amend section 926—113 of the statutes, relating to the improvement of inner harbors and in aid of mavigation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 926—113 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 926—113. Any land needed for any of the purposes contemplated by this act may be taken or acquired by gift, grant, purchase or condemnation as in other cases. The title to any lands thus taken or acquired by any such city in this state may be donated or transferred by such city to the government of the United States of America, for the purpose of improving the inner harbor of any such city for the public use as contemplated by this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 172.

AN ACT to amend subsection 3 of section 1498s of the statutes, relating to hunting license fees.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 3 of section 1498s of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 1498s) 3. The county clerk shall receive with each such application for license the sum of one dollar, ten cents of which he shall retain as his personal fee and as compensation for services rendered the state, and the remainder he shall transmit to the state treasurer. The retention by any county clerk of any such ten-cent fee heretofore paid to such clerk is hereby legalized and authorized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
