CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to amend section 1947r of the statutes, relating to Domestic Life Insurance Companies.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1947r of the statutes is amended to read: Section 1947r. No domestic life insurance company transacting a mutual or participating business shall incur or expend in any one year for any salary, compensation or emolument to any officer, trustee, director or salaried employe of such company, either directly or indirectly, any sum in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars, unless in each case such greater sum shall be fixed by the unanimous vote of the board of trustees or directors at any regular meeting thereof, or unless a greater maximum shall have been fixed by a majority vote of the policyholders voting at any regular election of directors. Notice of the submission of such question shall be given by mail to each policyholder at the same time as the notice of election is required to be given.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to amend subdivision (d) of section 4562e of the statutes, relating to the close season for pheasants and quail.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (d) of section 4562e of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 4562e) (d) Any Mongolian, Chinese or English pheasant, *Hungarian partridge* or quail of any variety before the first day of October, A. D. * * * 1921.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
