CHAPTER 582.

AN ACT to create section 2394—18a of the statutes, relating to payments by counties, cities, villages and towns of awards made by the industrial commission under workmen's compensation act.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to the statutes a new section to read: Section 2394—18a. Whenever an award is made by the commission against any county, city, village or town, the person in whose favor it is made shall file a certified copy thereof with the county, city, village or town clerk, as the case may be. Within twenty days thereafter, unless an appeal is taken, such clerk shall draw an order on the county, city, village or town treasurer against which the award was made for the payment of the amount specified in the award. If upon appeal such award is affirmed in whole or in part the order for payment shall be drawn within ten days after a certified copy of such judgment is filed with the proper clerk. If more than one payment is provided for in the award or judgment, orders shall be drawn as the payments become due. The provisions of any statute relating to the filing of claims against, and the auditing, allowing and payment of claims by counties, cities, villages and towns shall not apply to the payment of an award or judgment under the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
