CHAPTER 585.

AN ACT to amend subsection 1 of section 172—30 of the statutes, making an appropriation for the dairy and food commissioner and ex officio state superintendent of weights and measures.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 1 of section 172—30 of the statutes is amended to read: (Section 172—30.) 1. There is * * * appropriated, * * on July 1, * * 1915, * * thirty-five thousand dollars, and annually beginning July 1, 1916, sixty thousand five hundred thirty-two dollars payable from any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, for the dairy and food commissioner and ex officio state superintendent of weights and measures to pay salaries, compensations and expenses and to otherwise carry into effect the powers, duties and functions provided by law for said commissioner and superintendent.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July 1, 1915. Approved August 18, 1915.

CHAPTER 586.

AN ACT to amend subsections 1 and 2 of section 1979m of the statutes, relating to state aid to firemen's associations.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsections 1 and 2 of section 1979m of the statutes are amended to read: (Section 1979m.) 1. On or before the first day of * * * August of each year the secretary of each firemen's association in Wisconsin, may file with the secretary of state a verified, itemized statement of all moneys disbursed by the association during the twelve months ending the preceding first day of * * * July, including separately a statement of all moneys disbursed for prizes and premiums in competition and contests held by such association during such twelve months.

2. On or before the first day of * * * September of each year there shall be paid to the treasurer of each association filing such statement, and having held during the year a firemen's tournament actually participated in by companies
