have authority from time to time to prescribe necessary changes in the system of accounts provided such changes are in accordance with the provisions of sections 567a to 567c, inclusive. To carry out the provisions of sections 567a to 567d, inclusive, the state board of control is authorized to employ a competent accountant or accountants. Expenses incurred under the provisions of sections 567a to 567d, inclusive, shall be charged to the general appropriation * * * for the board of control.

(Section 20.28) (4) Of the annual transactions of the state conference of charities and corrections, not more than two thousand copies, containing not more than two hundred and fifty pages each. The cost of such printing shall be charged to the general appropriation for the board of control;

(5) Where any appropriation is repealed or any balance of an appropriation is caused to revert, any indebtedness incurred under the authority of such appropriation or balance prior to the time as of which such repeal or reversion of balance is to take effect, shall be paid from the appropriation or balance thus repealed or reverted as the case may be unless otherwise specifically provided by law.
- (6) No appropriation shall be available for payment of any indebtedness incurred prior to the time as of which such appro-

priation is to take effect or for any other purpose than that for which it is made unless otherwise specifically provided by law,

(7) In any case where a continuing, nonlapsible appropriation is amended either as to amount or purpose, the balance shall go forward as if the same had not been amended and shall be available for the purposes and subject to the conditions or limitations set out in the appropriation as amended unless otherwise specifically provided by law.

Section 5. Twenty-six thousand six-hundred ninety-seven dollars and ninety cents of the balance of the appropriation here-tofore provided in subsection 44 of section 172—67 which remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, shall revert to the general fund and the balance is reappropriated to the board of control for the purchase of land at any of the state institutions under the said board and this appropriation shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

Section 6. Four thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 15 of section 172—67 for the operation of the state public school, which remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, is reappropriated to the board of control for the operation of the school for the blind and this appropriation shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

Section 7. Six thousand dollars of the appropriation here-tofore provided in subsection 23 of section 172—67 for the operation of the hospital for the criminal insane, which remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, is reappropriated to the board of control for the operation of the state hospital for the insane and this appropriation shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

Section 8. Fifteen thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 15 of section 172—67 for the operation of the state public school and thirteen thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 34 of section 172—67 for the operation of the home for feebleminded, which remain unexpended at the close of the business on June 30, 1915, are reappropriated to the board of control for the operation of the state prison and these appropriations shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

Section 9. Five thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 30 of section 172—67 for the operation of the industrial school for boys, which remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, is reappropriated to the board of control for property repairs and maintenance at the state prison and this appropriation shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

Section 10. Two thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 5 of section 172—67 for the operation of the northern hospital for the insane and ten thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 23 of section 172—67 for the operation of the hospital for the criminal insane and thirteen thousand dollars of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 27 of section 172—67 for the operation of the state reformatory, which remain unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, are reappropriated to the board of control for the objects set out in subsection 20 of section 172—67 of these appropriations shall be available to pay indebtedness incurred prior to July 1, 1915.

SECTION 11. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to make transfers of amounts at the Wisconsin state prison as follows: From the repairs and maintenance appropriation account to the operating appropriation account, one thousand nine hundred twenty-nine dollars and ninety-nine cents; from the new cell wing, tunnel, etc., appropriation account, to the operating appropriation account, twenty thousand seven hundred seventy-five dollars and ninety-six cents; from the new cell wing, tunnel, etc., appropriation account, to the repairs and maintenance appropriation account, nineteen dollars and sixty cents; from the new cell wing, tunnel, etc., appropriation account to the road construction appropriation account three dollars and twenty cents.

SECTION 12. The balance of the appropriation heretofore provided in subsection 43 of section 172—67 which remained unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 1915, is repealed and shall revert to the general fund.
