## CHAPTER 257

AN ACT to create section 925—48m of the statutes, relating to term of office of park commissioners in cities.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: Section 925—48m. In all cities, however organized, having a board of park commissioners appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the council of such city, the term of office of each commissioner shall continue for the period for which he shall have been appointed and until his successor shall have been appointed, confirmed and qualified.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 258

AN ACT to repeal section 2 of chapter 43, laws of 1860, and section 9 of chapter 97, laws of 1849, and to create a new section to be numbered section 2 of chapter 43, laws of 1860, relating to the board of trustees of Carroll College.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 43, laws of 1860, and section 9 of chapter 97, laws of 1849, are repealed.

SECTION 2. A new section is added to chapter 43, laws of 1860, to be numbered and to read: (Ch. 43, laws of 1860) Section 2. The board of trustees of Carroll College shall consist of twenty-five members, twenty-four of whom shall be elected by the synod of Wisconsin in connection with the general assembly of the Presbyterian church in the United States of America. The president of said college shall be the twenty-fifth member of said board of trustees. The twenty-four members of the board elected by the synod shall be divided into four classes of six members each, as now elected and constituted, and shall be elect-
