CHAPTER 586

AN ACT to amend subsection (6) of section 2351 of the statutes relating to the annulment of marriage contracts.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (6) of section 2351 of the statutes is amended to read:

(Section 2351) (6) At the suit of the wife when she was under the age of * * * *fifteen* years at the time of the marriage, unless such marriage be confirmed by her after arriving at such age.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 587

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 20.10 of the statutes, relating to the superintendent of public property and making an appropriation; and to repeal certain unexpended balances.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 20.10 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.10) (2) On July 1, * * * 1917, * * * *twenty* thousand dollars, to be used as a revolving appropriation for the purchase of a general stock of all necessary office supplies, telegraph and telephone service, postage and postal service, express, freight and drayage service, paper, except paper required by law to be furnished by the printing board, and all other materials, supplies, services and expense of a consumable nature which in the judgment of the requisitioning officers are required by the various offices in performing the powers, duties, functions and obligations imposed upon them by law. Whenever such materials, supplies, services, or expense, charged to this appropriation, are furnished to the various offices the cost thereof shall be charged over to the proper appropriations for such offices and credited back to this appropriation; and whenever any such materials or supplies, charged to this appropriation are sold as provided in subsection (2) of section 292 of the statutes, the pro-
