SECTION 4. Paragraph (i) of subsection (3) of section 20.41 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.41) (3) (i) On July 1, * * * 1917, two thousand five hundred dollars, and on July 1, * * * 1918, two thousand five hundred dollars, for the preparation and distribution of hog cholera serums, as provided in section * * * 36.21; and all moneys received under section * * * 36.21 shall be paid within one week after receipt into the university fund income, and are appropriated therefrom and added to the appropriations for carrying out the provisions of said sections.

SECTION 5. On July 1, 1917, the unexpended balances of the appropriations made by subsections (1) and (2) of section 20.04 of the statutes, shall revert to the general fund.

SECTION 6. There is added to section 38.01 of the statutes, a new subsection to be numbered and to read:

(38.01) (13) The state board of education for the biennium beginning July 1, 1917, shall authorize the superintendent of public property and the business manager of the university of Wisconsin to conduct and do the purchasing for the normal schools, the cost of such purchasing to be charged to the appropriation for the administration of the normal schools made by subsection (1) of section 20.38.

SECTION 7. Paragraph (b) of subsection (6) of section 20.60 of the statutes, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.

CHAPTER 631

AN ACT to create a new paragraph of subsection (8) of section 20.17 of the statutes, relating to the state tuberculosis sanatorium, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is added to subsection (8) of section 20.17 of the statutes, a new paragraph to read:

(20.17) (8) (f) On July 1, 1917, fifty thousand dollars, and on July 1, 1918, fifty thousand dollars, for the construction and

equipment of an infirmary; of the first amount not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars shall be available for purchase of land.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1917.

CHAPTER 632

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 20.05 of the statutes, relating to the state treasurer, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 20.05 of the statutes is amended to read:

(20.05) (1) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1917, * * * *twenty-six thousand four hundred* dollars for the execution of his functions. Of this there is allotted:

(a) To the state treasurer an annual salary of five thousand dollars.

(b) To the assistant state treasurer an annual salary of two thousand five hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. Any unexpended balance remaining in the appropriation made by subsection (1) of section 20.05 on July 1, 1917, shall revert to the general fund.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon July 1, 1917.

CHAPTER 633

AN ACT to repeal paragraph (1) of subsection 2 of Section 1728a—3; and to create a new paragraph of subsection 2 of Section 1728a—3 of the statutes, relating to child labor.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (1) of subsection 2 of section 1728a—3 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. A new paragraph is added to subsection 2 of section 1728a—3 of the statutes to read:

(Section 1728a—3.2) (1) Such evidence as is required by the industrial commission showing that such child is at least fourteen years of age. The industrial commission shall formulate and publish rules and regulations governing the proof
