CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to amend section 1409-1 of the statutes, relating to embalming.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1409—1 of the statutes is amended to read: Section 1409—1. The state board of health is hereby authorized and empowered to determine the qualifications necessary to enable any person to properly embalm dead human bodies and disinfect the premises. The said board, or some member thereof, shall examine all applicants for an embalmer's license and shall issue an embalmer's license to all persons who successfully pass such examination. No person shall embalm any dead human body, unless he or she shall hold a valid, unrevoked and unexpired license from the Wisconsin state board of health authorizing him to practice the art of embalming. It shall be unlawful for any person not a licensed embalmer as herein provided, to advertise, practice, or pretend to practice the art of embalming by either arterial or cavity treatment.
