AN ACT to amend subsection 4 of section 35.30 of the statutes, to change the name of the State Conference of Charities and Corrections to the State Conference of Social Work, and to provide for additional copies of the report of proceedings.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 4 of section 35.30 of the statutes is amended to read: (35.30) (4) The name of the State Conference of Charities and Corrections is changed to the State Conference of Social Work. Of the annual transactions of the * * State Conference of Social Work, not more than two thousand copies, containing not more than two hundred fifty pages. * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 175.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 16.11 of the statutes, relating to civil service.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 16.11 of the statutes is amended to read: (16.11) (2) The competitive examinations shall be free and open to all applicants who are citizens of the United States and of this state and who have fulfilled the preliminary requirements stated in section 16.12, and shall be held at such times and places as in the judgment of the commission, most nearly meet the convenience of applicants and the needs of the service. The civil service commission may, through special action, open competitive examinations to residents of other states who are citizens of the United States and who have fulfilled the preliminary requirements stated in section 1612.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
