## CHAPTER 666.

AN ACT to amend section 4423a of the statutes, relating to the unauthorized wearing or use of the insignia, rosette, or badge of any society, order or organization, operating under the lodge system and prescribing a penalty.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 4423a of the statutes is amended to read: Section 4423a. Any person who shall wilfully wear the insignia, \* \* \* rosette, or badge or any imitation thereof, of the military order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, \* \* \* the Grand Army of the Republic, \* \* \* the United Spanish War Veterans, or \* \* \* the military order of Foreign Wars, or of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States, Knights of Columbus, Odd Fellows, Free Masons, Knights of Pythias, or of any other society, order, or organization, operating under the lodge system, of ten years standing in the State of Wisconsin, or shall wilfully use the same to obtain aid or assistance thereby within this state, or shall wilfully use the name of such society, order or organization, the titles of its officers, or its insignia, unless he shall be entitled to use or wear the same under the constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations \* \* \* thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail not more than thirty days or by a fine not exceeding twenty dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
