

shall provide for a nonpartisan management thereof, and shall create for each or all such utilities, a board of three or five or seven commissioners, to take entire charge and management of such utility, to appoint a manager and fix his compensation, and to supervise the operation of the utility under the general control and supervision of the board or council.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 196.

AN ACT authorizing the conveyance of a part of the armory grounds at Oconomowoc to the city of Oconomowoc.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners of public lands are hereby authorized, instructed and directed to transfer and convey to the city of Oconomowoc, Wisconsin, the following described premises situated in Waukesha county, Wisconsin, to-wit: All that part of lots sixty-one and sixty-two in Edwards Plat of Summit Addition to the city of Oconomowoc, according to the recorded plat thereof, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the north line of said lot sixty-two, one hundred feet west of the northeast corner of said lot sixty-two; thence west one hundred feet along the north line of said lot to a point; thence south parallel with the east line of said lot three hundred feet to a point; thence east parallel with the north line of said lot sixty-one, two hundred feet to the east line of said lot; thence north along the east line of said lots eighty feet to a point; thence west one hundred feet parallel with the north line of said lots to a point; thence north two hundred twenty feet to the point of commencement.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
