## CHAPTER 293.

AN ACT to amend the introductory paragraph of subsection (1) and subsection (4) of section 20.33 of the statutes, relating to the state board of vocational education, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in the Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The introductory paragraph to subsection (1) and subsection (4) of section 20.33 of the statutes are amended to read: (20.33) (1) (Introductory Paragraph) On July 1, 1923, not to exceed twenty-eight thousand three hundred dollars, and annually, beginning \* \* July 1, \* \* 1926, not to exceed twenty-eight thousand three hundred dollars, for the administrative expenses of the board. Of this there is allotted:

(4) Annually, beginning July 1, 1923, not to exceed twenty
\* \* eight thousand \* \* \* dollars as state aid for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation of persons disabled in industry or otherwise, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 41.215 of the statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1925. Approved June 10, 1925.

## CHAPTER 294.

AN ACT to appropriate three thousand dollars to the treasurer of the board of managers of the Wisconsin veterans' home from the general fund as a deficiency appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in the Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the treasurer of the board of managers of the Wisconsin veterans' home three thousand dollars as a deficiency appropriation for operation, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925.
