CHAPTER 46

AN ACT to amend subsection (5) of section 70.11 of the statutes, relating to property exempt from taxation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 70.11 of the statutes is amended to read: (70.11) (5) Property owned and used exclusively by any state or county agricultural society, or by any corporation or association formed under the laws of this state for the encouragement of industry by agricultural and industrial fairs and exhibitions, necessary for fairgrounds or for exhibition and sale of agricultural and dairy stock, products and property, while used exclusively for that purpose, not exceeding eighty acres; provided, that such corporations or associations may permit such fairgrounds or other property to be used for celebrations or as places of amusement.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 40.30 of the statutes relating to instruction in physical education in rural schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 40.30 of the statutes is amended to read: (40.30) (3) (a) The school board or board of education in each school district shall make provision for the instruction and training of all pupils under its jurisdiction in physical education; provided, that in one or two-room schools such instruction and training shall take the form of supervised playground work.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
