CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (7) of 40.09 of the statutes relating to powers of school district electors.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a), subsection (7) of section 40.09 of the statutes is amended to read: (40.09) (7) (a) To authorize and direct the sale of any school * * buildings, * * to * the district when * the shall be no longer needed for the use of the district; provided that * if the school site or other lands * * are leased or rented with the understanding that * they shall revert to the owner of the land from which it is taken, the electors * * shall authorize the board to sell or move the * buildings * * to * * another site, if such sale or removal or both shall be made within eight months after the * buildings shall cease to be used for school purposes or the site ceases to be maintained as a district playground or park

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT to repeal chapter 115 of the laws of 1879 and chapter 8 of the laws of 1905, and all acts amendatory thereof, relating to the municipal court of Marathon county, and to confer on the county court of Marathon county civil and criminal jurisdiction.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 115 of the laws of 1879 and chapter 8 of the laws of 1905, and all acts amendatory thereof, are repealed, and there shall be no election of a judge of the municipal court of Marathon county after the passage and publication of this act.
