CHAPTER 326.

AN ACT to create subsection (5) of section 70.26 of the statutes, relating to platting of lands for assessment purpose in counties having a population of two hundred and fifty thousand or more.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 70.26 of the statutes to read: (70.26) (5) In counties having a population of two hundred and fifty thousand or more, the powers and duties herein provided, except as to the publication of notice, shall be exercised by the county board upon request of the town or village board or boards affected; provided that the costs and expenses of such plats shall be paid by the county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 327.

AN ACT to repeal section 352.56 and to create a new section to be numbered 352.56 of the statutes, relating to the sale, delivery and exchange of bakery products and providing a penalty.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 352.56 of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 2. A new section is added to the statutes to be numbered and to read: 352.56 (1) The sale and delivery of bakery products shall be so conducted as to prevent the distribution of contamination, infection or disease among consumers and to protect the food supply of the state against waste.

(2) For the purpose of this section the term "person" shall mean and include any and all persons, firms or corporations engaged in the business of manufacturing, buying, selling or dealing in bakery products within the state. The term "bakery prod-
