CHAPTER 361.

AN ACT to amend subsection (4) of section 29.18 of the statutes, relating to a close season for muskrats.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (4) of section 29.18 of the statutes is amended to read: (29.18) (4) For mink and muskrat there shall be an open season from January first to April tenth, in all counties excepting the counties of Calumet, Fond du Lac, Green Lake, Marquette, Outagamie, Shawano, Waushara, Waupaca, Marathon, Lincoln, Forest, Florence, Oneida, Langlade, Marinette and Winnebago where the open season shall be from October twentyfifth to April first. There shall be no open season in Vernon * * and Richland counties. There shall be po open season for muskrat in Pike lake in the towns of Reid and Elderon, and in May Flower lake and Lake Gotoit, in the town of Norrie, Marathon county.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT to amend section 32.04, subsection (1) of section 32.07, section 32.09, subsections (1), (4) and (4a) of section 32.10 and section 32.11; and to create subsections (3a) and (4b) of section 32.10 of the statutes, relating to the acquisition of property by cities, villages and towns through condemnation and the assessment of benefits and damages.
