

vided each be under the separate supervision of a registered pharmacist. For the registration of every place herein required to be registered, there shall be paid an annual registration fee of one dollar, payable on the first day of June of each year. Any person failing to register his place of business as herein required, failing to have in charge of each pharmacy a registered pharmacist who does not manage or supervise more than one pharmacy, or who otherwise fails to comply with the provisions of this section, shall, upon conviction, be fined the sum of not more than fifty dollars for each separate offense.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 449.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 87.04 of the statutes, relating to the building of bridges on state trunk highways.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (1) of section 87.04 of the statutes is amended to read: (87.04) (1) Whenever any county, by its county board shall file a petition with the state highway commission setting forth that said county desires the construction or reconstruction of a bridge on the state trunk highway system, or on a road or street within a city of the fourth class, forming a direct connection between portions of the state trunk highway system, across any navigable waters in said county, or on which said county may border, and that said construction or reconstruction is necessary, the state highway commission shall fix a time and place for hearing and hear said petition in the manner provided in section 87.02. * * *

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
