CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 61.50 of the statutes, relating to the enactment of village ordinances.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 61.50 of the statutes is amended to read: (61.50) (1) Every contract, conveyance, commission, license or other written instrument shall be executed on the part of the village by the president and clerk, sealed with the corporate seal, and in pursuance only of authority therefor from the village board. All ordinances and by-laws shall be signed by the president and countersigned by the clerk; and, if any penalty or forfeiture is thereby, in any event imposed, shall, before taking effect, be published one week at least in some newspaper printed in the village, and if there be no newspaper printed in such village, the village board may designate a newspaper having a general circulation in said village and printed in the county, in which such village is located, or may, in lieu of the printing thereof, have copies of said ordinances and by-laws posted in at least three public places in said village, and proof thereof filed and recorded by the village clerk one

week before the same shall take effect. Every ordinance or bylaw heretofore posted, filed and recorded as herein provided, is hereby validated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT to amend section 61.35 of the statutes relating to village planning.

Any ordinance or resolution heretofore passed by any village board under the provisions of section 61.35 shall be and remain in full force and effect until repealed or amended by such village board; in case the village has no official paper, the notice specified in paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section 62.23 shall be posted in three public places in said village at least ten days prior to the date of hearing therein specified.
