CHAPTER 184.

AN ACT to create paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section 20.16 of the statutes, relating to fines collected by the state historical society and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

A new paragraph is added to subsection (1) of section 20.16 of the statutes to read: (20.16) (1) (g) All fines collected by said society shall be paid within one week after receipt into the general fund and are appropriated therefrom to the state historical society as an additional appropriation to carry out its powers, duties and functions.

CHAPTER 185.

AN ACT to amend subsection (1) of section 343.413 of the statutes, relating to fraudulent advertising.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 343.413 of the statutes is amended to read: (343.413) (1) No person, firm, corporation or association shall, with intent to sell or in anywise dispose of real estate, merchandise, securities, service, or anything offered by such person, firm, corporation or association, directly or indirectly, to the public for sale or distribution, or with intent to increase the consumption thereof, or to induce the public in any manner to enter into any obligation relating thereto, or to acquire title thereto, or an interest therein, make, publish, disseminate, circulate, or place before the public, or cause, directly or indirectly, to be made, published, disseminated, circulated, or placed before the public, in this state, in a newspaper or other publication, or in the form of a book, notice, handbill, poster, bill, circular, pamphlet, or letter, or in any other way, an advertisement of any sort regarding real estate, merchandise, securities,
