## CHAPTER 190.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (8) of section 27.01 of the statutes, relating to the acquisition of Copper Falls Park.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (8) of section 27.01 of the statutes is amended to read: (27.01) (8) (a) The conservation commission is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations for the acquisition by purchase, donation or otherwise of suitable areas for park and recreational purposes in sections seventeen and twenty in township forty-five, range two west, Ashland county, commonly known as "Copper Falls."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

## **CHAPTER 191.**

- AN ACT to provide for the publication of a new and complete edition of Wisconsin Annotations to the Wisconsin constitution and statutes, and to amend sections 20.64 and 35.23 of the statutes, relative thereto and making an appropriation therefor.
- The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The revisor of statutes shall prepare and deliver to the printing board as soon as practicable after the end of the regular legislative session of 1929, printer's copy for a volume to be designated "Wisconsin Annotations" and to contain the Wisconsin constitution, notes of the legislative history of the several sections of the statutes, and annotations of court decisions interpreting the Wisconsin constitution and statutes, and such other matter as he may deem important to be included. The printing board shall order printed, and the state printer shall print and deliver, within ninety days after the receipt of the last of said copy, an edition of five thousand copies.
