CHAPTER 297.

AN ACT to amend subsection (3) of section 96.01 of the statutes, relating to noxious weeds.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (3) of section 96.01 of the statutes is amended to read: (96.01) (3) In cities of the third and fourth classes, and in towns in counties having a population of twentyfive thousand or more in lieu of the notice required under subsection (2), annual notice to cut or destroy all noxious weeds listed shall be given as provided in this subsection to every person, firm or corporation owning, occupying or controlling any land therein. The mayor of each such city or chairman of such town shall cause such notice to be published for two consecutive weeks, in one or more papers having general circulation in such city or town, the first publication to be had on or before the fifteenth day of June in each year. If there be no newspaper published in said town, such notice shall be posted in five prominent places in such town for two weeks prior to June fifteenth of each year. Failure to publish notice as herein provided shall not relieve any landowner or renter of property from the provisions of sections 96.01 to 96.03.
