CHAPTER 308.

AN ACT to create subsection (30a) of section 61.34 of the statutes, relating to the contracting for water supply by villages.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new subsection is added to section 61.34 of the statutes to read: (61.34) (30a) To enter into any contract with any corporation formed under general or special law for the purpose of constructing and operating waterworks in any village, to have such corporation supply such village with water for fire and other purposes upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon, and to grant such corporation the right to use any street, alley, lane, park or public ground for laying water pipes therein, provided no permanent injury shall be done to the same.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 309.

AN ACT to amend paragraph (a) of subsection (20) of section 20.17 of the statutes, relating to funds derived from prison industries.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (20) of section 20.17 of the statutes is amended to read: (20.17) (20) (a) On July 1, 1919, fifteen thousand dollars, and from time to time, sums equal in amount to the moneys derived from the sale of products of the industries of the state prison other than the binder twine plant, and the marble industry, and paid into the general fund, to be used as a revolving appropriation to carry on such industries at the state prison and for the construction and equipment of buildings, for permanent property and improvements. No expenditures shall be made from this appropriation for the construction and equipment of buildings or for permanent property
