CHAPTER 326.

AN ACT to provide for a special committee to study a retirement plan for state employes for submission to the next legislature, and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is constituted a special committee consisting of one senator and two assemblymen, to be appointed as standing committees are appointed, and two state employes to be appointed by the governor. Said committee shall study and report in bill form to the next regular session of the legislature a plan of retirement for state employes. The committee shall confer and advise with the commissioner of insurance who is directed to make such actuarial investigation as may be necessary to aid the committee in its work.

SECTION 2. Said committee shall organize by electing a chairman and a secretary. The members of the committee shall receive no compensation for services but shall be reimbursed for expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties. The committee may employ such clerical assistance as it may deem necessary and fix the compensation thereof. All expenses and accounts of the committee shall be presented for payment upon vouchers signed by the chairman and shall be paid as other accounts against the state are paid.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the general fund the sum of one thousand dollars to carry out the provisions of this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
