CHAPTER 484.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money named herein to the Wisconsin deep waterways commission, created by chapter 377, laws of 1919.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund to the Wisconsin deep waterways commission, created by chapter 377, laws of 1919, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1930, six thousand two hundred fifty dollars; and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1931, six thousand two hundred fifty dollars for the execution of its functions, provided that no part of this appropriation shall be available except upon the approval of the governor, and provided further, that the members of said commission shall receive their actual expenses but no compensation.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.

CHAPTER 485.

AN ACT to amend section 20.21 of the statutes, relating to the state superintendent of public instruction and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 20.21 of the statutes is amended to read: 20.21 There is appropriated from the general fund to the state superintendent:

(1) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1929, one hundred * * * *fourteen thousand five hundred* dollars for the execution of his functions. Of this there is allotted:

(a) To the state superintendent an annual salary of * * * *six thousand* dollars.

(b) Not to exceed two hundred and fifty dollars to carry out the provisions of subsection (8) of section 14.57.

(2) Annually, beginning July 1, 1927, not to exceed four

thousand two hundred dollars for institutes for the instruction of teachers pursuant to section 37.14, and for conducting a state teachers' and a state young people's reading circle organized by the Wisconsin teachers' association. Not to exceed two thousand dollars of this appropriation is allotted, annually, for such reading circles.

(3) Annually, beginning July 1, * * * 1929, not to exceed * * * *twenty-seven thousand five hundred* dollars to carry out the provisions of subsection (4) of section 41.01.

CHAPTER 486.

AN ACT to create section 20.121 of the statutes, providing for the erection of a state office building under the direction of a state office commission and making an appropriation.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section is added to the statutes to read: 20.121 There is appropriated from the state insurance fund to the state office building commission on September 1, 1929, two hundred thousand dollars and on July 1, 1930, four hundred thousand dollars, for the purchase of the site, the construction and equipment of the state office building, necessary tunnels to connect said building with the capitol lighting system and all other expenses necessarily incident to the erection of the said state office building. This appropriation shall be available in installments as needed upon certification by the chairman and secretary of the commission, with the approval of the governor.

SECTION 2. A commission is hereby created to consist of the five members of the special joint committee appointed pursuant to Joint Resolution No. 5, S., namely, Senators Goodland and Otto Mueller and Assemblymen Laffey, Rowlands and Martin, for the construction of an adequate and substantial fireproof state office building, to furnish proper accommodations for various departments of the state government. A majority of the members of said commission shall have power to act for the same.
