CHAPTER 234.

AN ACT to amend subsection (2) of section 202.11 of the statutes, relating to notice of assessment of town mutual insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection (2) of section 202.11 of the statutes is amended to read: (202.11) (2) When any assessment shall have been completed the secretary shall immediately insert a notice in one or more newspapers printed in the county or counties where the corporation is doing business, stating the amount of the assessment, the time such assessment was levied, and the time when the same becomes due. Such notice together with the proof of the publication thereof shall be conclusive evidence of notice of such assessment to every member. The secretary shall also notify every member by mail of the * * * rate per cent of such assessment, and the sum due from him, and the time when due, and to whom payment is to be made, which time shall not be less than thirty nor more than sixty days from the date of such notice. If the insurance is payable to a mortgagee and the assessment thereon is not paid within the time specified, the secretary shall within thirty days after the expiration of such time give like notice to the mortgagee. The mortgagee shall have twenty days from the date of such notice to pay the assessment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and publication.
